8-21-23, 1530 hrs.

Rite Aid, 176 Saxon Ave, reported a theft from the register. The store supervisor said a male customer was able to download \$500 from the register with his Cash App. There have been several thefts throughout area Rite Aids using the same Cash App scam. Det. Kyle Cutcliff is investigating.

8-24-23, 1521 hrs.

Target, 857 Baltimore Pike, reported a theft in progress with the suspect fleeing the store. Officers checked the area and located Clifton Brandon, 45 years old from Philadelphia, who matched the description provided by security. Brandon attempted to steal \$1,053 of over-the-counter medications. He committed a prior theft on 8/22/23 and stole \$1,422 of over-the-counter medications, but was not apprehended. He was in possession \$732 of CVS merchandise which had been stolen earlier in the day and had a warrant out of Montgomery County for, you guessed it, Retail Theft. Brandon was turned over to police and charged with Retail Theft. He was held for arraignment.
