4-9-18 0830 hrs.

The construction company doing work on Powell Rd. reported that sometime over the weekend someone had overturned their Porta Potty which had been in the lot of Williams Park. The unit was also pushed into the creek that runs through the park.

4-10-18 0746 hrs.

An early morning traffic detail led to the arrest of an adult male from Drexel Hill. The male failed to stop for a red signal on State Rd. at Meetinghouse Ln. and was stopped by Ofc. Christy at Collins Dr. Ofc. Christy found a quantity of marijuana inside the vehicle along with drug paraphernalia. The male was taken into custody, processed and released with charges for drug violations pending.

Early morning Eagles workout. Media Police reported a male subject wearing an Eagles hooded sweatshirt exited a friend's vehicle in the borough and started acting erratically heading towards Springfield. A short time later Sgt. Officers learned the suspect had entered the bank, demanded money from a teller, and left the bank running down Chester Rd. towards Swarthmore Av. Ofc.
