3-27-18 1021 hrs.

Officers investigated a reckless driver on the 200 block N. State Rd. who had struck trash cans on Township Line Rd. in Upper Darby. Sgt. Purcell and Officer Robbins stopped a Mazda vehicle and made contact with the driver. During this contact, Officers located a quantity of narcotics and drug paraphernalia inside the vehicle.
