8-21-17 1035 hrs.

Target at the mall security stopped Iqbal Chowdhury 41 yrs. old from Buffalo, NY after observing him steal \$150.00 worth of merchandise. He was taken into custody by police and charged with Retail Theft.

8-21-17 1538 hrs.

Target at the mall security observed two females in the jewelry department each select bracelets and place them on their wrists. The females then went to the shoe department and concealed a pair of sneakers. Both then attempted to leave the store not paying for the merchandise. Shekira Jenkins 20 yr. old and Janai Selby-Eaddy 32 yr. old both from Wilmington were taken into custody and cited for Retail Theft.
