12-11-17 1023 hrs.

The Springfield High School reported a student in the principal's office for selling pills. Another student alerted staff that he was messaged through Snap Chat to buy pills. School officials spoke to the suspected student and found that he was in possession of loose pills. Police later identified the pills as Clonazepam, a schedule 4 narcotic. The suspected student will be charged through juvenile petition for Possession of a Controlled Substance. Det. Bridget McCarthy is handling the investigation.

12-12-17 1033 hrs.

Citadel Federal Credit Union, 943 W. Sproul Rd., reported a fraudulent bank withdrawal in progress. Two females in a silver Hyundai were in the drive through lane attempting to make a cash withdrawal from a compromised checking account. The account had been "flagged" due previous fraudulent activity. While police were en route, the vehicle left the bank. Officers were able to stop the vehicle nearby and the occupants were positively identified by witnesses.
