2-17-20 1649 hrs.

Target at the mall security reported a female stopped for stealing over \$160 worth of jewelry, cosmetics, and infant items. Laura Newkirk 35 yrs. old from Essington was taken into custody and charged with Retail Theft. She was held for arraignment.

2-18-20 1000 hrs.

The Springfield Parks Department reported playground equipment had been vandalized sometime over the weekend. Vandals put graffiti using black marker on two slides.

2-18-20 1357 hrs.

Target at the mall security reported observing a female select plastic storage totes from display and walk out of the store failing to pay for the totes which were valued at over \$100.
