Press Release January 29, 2018

January 22, 2018 1423 hrs.

Police responded to the Cricket Wireless store on the 400 block of Baltimore Pk. for a report that three males had entered the store and removed an Iphone 7 from display and ran out of the store. A short time later, three males entered the Verizon Go Wireless store on the 1000 block Baltimore Pk. and removed a Samsung Note 8 from display and ran out of the store. Det. Devaney is handling the investigation.

January 22, 2018 1910 hrs.

Macy's Security at the mall reported three males were in the store and removed numerous North Face jackets from display and left the store without paying for the jackets. They left the mall lot in a vehicle. Det. McNeely is investigating the theft.
