6-12-17 @ 0653 hrs.

Three suites in the Springfield Hospital were forcibly entered sometime over the previous weekend. Attempts were made to steal from employee lockers and a business safe. At the time of the reports nothing was reported to be missing.

6-12-17 @ 1047 hrs.

Officers responded to a report of gunshots being fired in the rear wooded area of the 400 block E. Woodland Av. While checking the area Ofcs. Clifton and Francis found the shots had been coming from a house on the 400 block. A resident, Moses Magera 37 yrs. old, was found inside and arrested. A firearm was recovered from the house. Magera was charged with Reckless Endangerment, Risking a Catastrophe, and other crimes. He was held and arraigned at district court.

6-12-17 1555 hrs.

Several male juveniles were stopped and investigated for throwing numerous trash cans into parked cars and into the street along the 200 block of Powell Rd. Two cars were found to have minor damage. Charges are pending further investigation.

6-15-17 @ 2333 hrs.

Officers responded to an accident scene at State Rd. and Springfield Rd. and found the driver of a Toyota vehicle, an adult male from Glen Mills, unconscious. He was found to have overdosed on Heroin, and was given Narcan by Sgt. McKinney which revived him. He was taken to a hospital for medical treatment and submitted to a blood test. Charges against him are pending.

6-16-17 @ 1942 hrs.

Two juvenile males both from Springfield were cited for Disorderly Conduct after causing a disturbance inside the Target Store at the Mall.

6-17-17 @ 1644 hrs.

Daniel Connors 27 yrs. old from Glenolden was arrested for taking three women's dresses valued at \$640 from the Macy's Store at the Mall. He was held and later arraigned at district court.

6-18-17 @ 0115 hrs.

Officers were dispatched to the Miller's Ale House lot for an assault that had just occurred. The female victim reported being struck in the face and kicked by male subject whom she knew. The male fled the scene prior to police arrival. Investigation is continuing.

An investigation into three recent burglaries over the past month including the Happy Wok Restaurant, M&A Nails, and Bamboo Nails and Spa by Det. Nutley and Ofc. Shull led to the arrest of Jamie Campbell 46 yrs. old male from Chester. Campbell was found to have forcibly entered the businesses and took a varying amount of cash from the cash registers at each location.
