2-25-20 1747 hrs.

Officers responded to the Target at the mall to investigate a theft. They found that a female had selected numerous items of clothing and infant products and went to a fitting room. She exited the fitting room with the items concealed in an infant bag and personal handbag. She then hurried out of the store not paying for the items. Target security recognized the female from prior thefts. The female, 24 yrs. old from Philadelphia, will be charged with Retail Theft. Det. McCarthy is handling the investigation.

Officers responded to a fight involving two females in the parking lot of Qdoba Mexican Grill 1000 block Baltimore Pk. As a female arrived at the restaurant to pick up food, she was approached by a second female who punched her in the face and fled.
