3-5-19 1626 hrs.

A resident of the 100 block of Broadview Rd. reported sometime overnight someone entered his unlocked vehicle and removed his wallet from the center cup holder.

3-7-19 1504 hrs.

Target security 800 block Baltimore Pk. reported observing a female select numerous items of clothing, baby items, and health items and place them in a shopping cart. She proceeded through the self-checkout line and put \$8 cash into the register. She then attempted to leave the store without paying for the rest of the items.
