10-8-18 1658 hrs.

A patron who had been eating at Panera Bread 1000 block Baltimore Pk. reported that her wallet was removed from her purse as the purse hung from the back of her chair. Credit cards were found to be used after the fact.

10-9-18 0059 hrs.

A resident of the 200 block Pancoast Av. reported observing a male subject attempting to steal from inside a vehicle. The witness also observed a second subject flee the area driving a vehicle. As officers responded, Ofc. Oswald observed the vehicle involved driving erratically on Powell Rd. at Leamy Av. The vehicle struck a street sign and then sped off west on Leamy Av. As Ofc. Oswald attempted to catch up to the vehicle, he found the vehicle crashed on the property on the 300 block W. Leamy Av. The female driver was secured with the help of Springfield Fire Co.
