4-24-17 @1357 hrs.

Employees of the Giant Store 950 Baltimore Pk. observed a male subject conceal 15 DVDs totaling about \$300.00 in a zippered jacket and flee the store. He entered a silver Chevrolet Impala and left the area. Det. McNeely is investigating.

4-24-17 @1500 hrs.

Kelly Lawlor 27 yrs. from Wilmington, De was arrested after she was observed by Macy's Security attempting to leave the store failing to pay for \$303.29 worth of clothing and other merchandise. A criminal complaint was prepared by Det. McCarthy, and Lawlor was taken for arraignment.
