**Route 101: Woodland Avenue Station Drainage Work
Friday, December 1 at 8:00 PM – Monday, December 4 at 4:00 AM**

*Shuttle Buses Will Replace All Route 101 Trolleys Between 69th Street
Transportation Center and Media (Orange Street)*

Beginning **Friday, December 1 at 8:00 PM** and concluding **Monday, December 4 at 4:00 AM** SEPTA and third-party forces will be performing track construction and maintenance work along the Route 101 Trolley Line. Trench drain work at Woodland Avenue Station will require work to be performed during nighttime hours. Residents in the area may notice construction noise and vehicle sounds, including backup alerts and construction lighting.

During this period of weekend work, buses will replace all Route 101 Trolleys between 69th Street Transportation Center and Media (Orange Street). Customers should plan for approximately 15 minutes of additional travel time and look for signage at stations for bus boarding locations. Residents, pedestrians and motorists are reminded to be aware of their surroundings near construction work and observe all posted signage regarding bus location pick up and drop off.
