01-09-17 @ 1508 HRS.

The AT&T Store in the Springfield Mall reported that sometime during the afternoon on 01-08, surveillance video showed a male leaving the store without paying for a SAMSUNG GEAR FIT 2 cellular phone from a display in the front of the store. The phone is valued at \$179.00.
