10-10-16 @ 1423 HRS.

Macy's Security reported that a male just fled the store w/out paying for a bag of merchandise. Store security stopped the actor who dropped the bag and fled onto a Septa bus. A short time later, Ptlm. Joseph Prendergast and Ptlm. Joseph O'Berg stopped the bus On Sproul Rd. at Baltimore Pk. The actor, listed below, was identified by store security and taken into custody. He was transported to the Springfield Police Station and charged with Retail Theft for taking \$418.78 worth of merchandise from the store and Receiving Stolen Property. Detective Sgt. John DiTrollo is handling the investigation.

The Giant Food Store in the 900 Blk. of Baltimore Pk. reported that they had four females in custody for Retail Theft at the store. Ptlm.
