10-17-16 @ 0913 HRS.

A resident from the Unit Blk. of Saxer Ave. reported that sometime during the night someone egged her vehicle while it was parked on Orchard Rd. next to the home.

10-17-16 @ 1516 HRS.

The Springfield Ford Auto Dealership in the Unit Blk. of Baltimore Pk. reported that sometime during the night someone stole a black colored 2017 Lincoln Continental from the rear lot of the business. The vehicle is valued in excess of \$55,000.00.
