4-17-25 2015 hrs.

A male reported his Go Trax bicycle stolen from Walsh Park sometime between 1800 and 1930 hrs. He said he tried to hide the bike while he left the park for a period of time, but when he returned it was missing.

Officers were called to Springfield Rd. near Bishop Av. for a report of a reckless driver. A witness then reported the vehicle struck an unknown vehicle on Bishop Av. and continued to drive onto Baltimore Pk. The vehicle tried to evade witnesses and responding police and drove into a parking lot on Baltimore Pk. in Upper Darby Twp. before finally being stopped.
