2-10-26 1231 hrs.

Jose Batch, 66 yrs. old from Broomall, was charged with Retail Theft after he was observed stealing close to \$250 worth of merchandise from Target at the mall by ringing lower priced items and concealing other items inside reusable bags. He was held for arraignment.

Officer Ritter stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation and for displaying a suspended license plate on the unit block Baltimore Pk. The driver was identified as a 22 yr. old male from Drexel Hill and was unable to provide proof of insurance. While his vehicle was being towed the driver refused to leave the area and threatened officers on scene. He was taken into custody and will be charged with Obstruction of Justice and other offenses.
