9-26-22 1050 hrs.

Officers stopped a vehicle in the parking lot of the Days Inn 600 block Baltimore Pk. of which the registration was reported stolen out of Philadelphia. Contact was made with the driver who was displaying the registration on a different vehicle than assigned. The driver, a 40 yr. old male from Philadelphia, was found in possession of a firearm and a quantity of marijuana and drug paraphernalia. The vehicle was seized pending a search warrant. Det.
