9-17-24 2002 hrs.

Officers were called to the CVS parking lot 300 block Baltimore Pk. to investigate three subjects showing signs of intoxication and a possible theft. Officers located two males and a female in the rear who appeared to be suffering an opioid overdose. CVS employees reported the two males had stolen over \$430 worth of eye products. All three subjects were taken into custody and provided medical assistance. A 40 yr. old male from Coatesville, 36 yr. old male from Oceanside, NY will be charged with Retail Theft and Public Drunkenness.

9-18-24 0411 hrs.

Officers were called to the 600 block Baltimore Pk. to investigate a male and female causing a disturbance by yelling and walking into traffic. It was found the two were together and having a verbal altercation. A 24 yr. old female and 26 yr. old male both from Philadelphia will be charged with Disorderly Conduct.
