12-10-18 1418 hrs.

A person reported she was scammed out of \$400. She claimed she met a friend of a friend who said he worked for Best Buy and would upgrade her phone from an Iphone X to Iphone XR. She picked up this friend in Philadelphia and drove to Best Buy on Baltimore Pk. She gave him \$400 and he walked into Best Buy only to not return.
