1-30-20 2023 hrs.

Officers responded to the 500 block Sheffield Dr. to investigate a suspicious person a resident observed on a surveillance camera. Further investigation revealed the male had loitered in a driveway for some time and entered the neighbor's vehicle and rummaged through it. Nothing was missing. Officers then went to a residence on the 200 block E. Thomson Av. and found a purse had been removed from a vehicle there. An attempt was made on the 600 block Newlin Rd. but nothing was taken, and an Officer on foot patrol in the area heard the suspect close a car door in a driveway on the 600 block Prospect Rd. but was unable to locate the suspect.
