7-9-19 0650 hrs.

A resident of the 800 block Grove Av. reported sometime overnight someone slashed two tires of his vehicle and put a dent into the passenger door as the vehicle was parked on the street.

A resident of the 400 block Indian Rock Dr. reported she was contacted via phone by a computer company offering her a refund on a service contract because they were going out of business. They gained access to her computer and forced her to make a purchase of gift cards to get it back. This was found to be a scam. Note: Whenever phone conversations turn to making a purchase of gift cards, one should recognize the fraud and end the conversation.

A female reported that while sitting at Panera Bread her wallet was removed from her purse, and the credit cards inside were used to make unauthorized purchases at several stores. Det. Devaney is investigating.
