Press Release June 3, 2019

5-27-19 0643 hrs.

Officers investigated a vehicle crash on the 100 block Parkview Dr. in which a vehicle struck a parked vehicle. The driver of the striking vehicle, a 28 yr. old female from Springfield, was found at the scene and determined to be intoxicated. The female submitted to a blood test and remained at headquarters until released to family later.

5-27-19 1342 hrs.

Officers responded to the mall to investigate an altercation between two females. They learned that one of the females while shopping at Victoria's Secret placed her shopping bag down on a table which was later stolen. The victim looked around the mall for someone whom she believed stole the bag and located a female on the first floor. While both parties were being escorted by mall security back to Victoria's Secret to settle the matter, the females began to hit each other. Mall security was then able to control the group until officers arrived. Two females both of Philadelphia were cited for Disorderly Conduct.

5-28-19 0134 hrs.

Two parked vehicles along the 900 block Stoneybrook Rd. were struck by a moving vehicle. The driver of the moving vehicle was found to be intoxicated. The 26 yr. old male from Drexel Hill was taken into custody and submitted to a blood test. He was later released to family.

Michelle Vance 26 yrs. old from Royersford was arrested and charged with Fraud and Identity Theft after attempting to pass a fraudulent check at the WSFS Bank drive thru on Saxer Av. Two males in the vehicle one juvenile and one adult were also held after being found to have active arrest warrants out of Delaware County and Manheim Twp.

Officers responded to the mall property to investigate a theft and the suspect had walked away from security. On arrival, Officers located the female outside walking away from the mall. was positively identified as Mahnya Saunders 19 yrs. old from Wilmington and charged with Retail Theft and held for arraignment.

Officers responded to a fight call on the unit block Shelburne Rd. The victim reported a male entered the house where the victim was staying and assaulted him by punching him in the face. The suspect left before police arrival. A short time later after an investigation, the suspect a 31 yr. old male from Springfield, turned himself in at headquarters. He will be charged with Simple Assault. Det. McNeely is handling the investigation.

Officers went to the Wine and Spirits Store 100 block Baltimore Pk. to investigate two subjects soliciting money. The subjects had been asked to leave multiple times by management of the store. They had also been asked to move on from the Best Buy store earlier in the day. Both subjects were found to be juveniles from Philadelphia, and both were picked up by family and left the area as officers stood by. A short time later, the two returned to the store, entered, and broke several bottles of liquor before fleeing in a vehicle. They will be charged with Criminal Mischief and Disorderly Conduct.
