PRESS RELEASE: November 5, 2024 Attempted Murder Investigation- Shops at Springfield Park

On Sunday October 13, 2024 at about 1600 hrs. police responded to a report of a shooting in the far rear area of the rear parking lot. Upon arrival officers located a male victim inside a vehicle injured from a gunshot wound. Medical treatment was initiated, and the victim was transported to a hospital by emergency personnel with serious injuries. Officers from Springfield Police secured the scene and began to collect information. Detectives Kyle Cutcliff and Robert Nutley responded to the scene along with members of Delaware County CID. Initial information revealed that a male subject operating a black colored Honda Odyssey pulled to the rear of the victim's vehicle and shot through the rear window of the victim's vehicle striking him at least once.

Information was put out to law enforcement agencies to stop and hold the Honda Odyssey for investigation. On October 18, 2024 the vehicle was located occupied by the owner in Fairfax City, VA. The vehicle was seized, and a search warrant executed by Detectives Cutcliff and Chris Karr of CID. Evidence was found during the execution of the search warrant that linked the vehicle to the shooting.

Evidence collected from the shooting scene and during the execution of the search warrant led to charges being filed on 11-1-24 against Jihad Henderson 36 yrs. old from Philadelphia. Charges of Attempted Murder, Aggravated Assault, and Possession of an Instrument of Crime were filed and an arrest warrant issued.

On 11-4-24, Henderson turned himself in to the Springfield Police. He was processed and held for arraignment. Later he was transported to Delaware County Prison.
